# AP and CE CREDITS

## Concurrent Enrollment (CE)

Weber State Class @ WHS

If you get a passing grade then you receive college credit. The grade goes on both your high school and college transcripts

Be admitted as a CE Student, then \$5 per credit (\$15 is the cost for 3 credit hrs)

English and Math classes have a GPA and/or an ACT score requirement

Withdrawing early gives you a "W" on your college transcript and may affect your ability to get financial aid

## Advanced Placement (AP)

If you pass the AP test at the end of the year with a score of 3 or above you receive college credits on your transcript.

Pay \$98 for each test

Credits transfer to universities across the nation.

The most competitive universities prefer AP scores over CE grades.

# What will AP or CE credit do for you?

- Some AP and CE credits count toward General Education Requirements
- General Ed requirements are the credits everyone needs at college no matter what their major is



# Certificate of Completion

- Certificate from Weber State University stating all General Education Requirements are fulfilled
- Present this to any State University or College in the state of UTAH, and General Education Requirements are waived. (Additional prerequisites may be required depending on degree)
- **Approximately 37 college credits** from both AP and CE Classes – you can complete the requirements at WHS
- **First step is to meet with our Weber State Advisor, Gino.**
- **Note: An Associates Degree at a university is DIFFERENT and requires 60 credits.**

- Counselors will be available to talk with you and your parents about your choices, during Parent Teacher Conference on February 21<sup>st</sup>

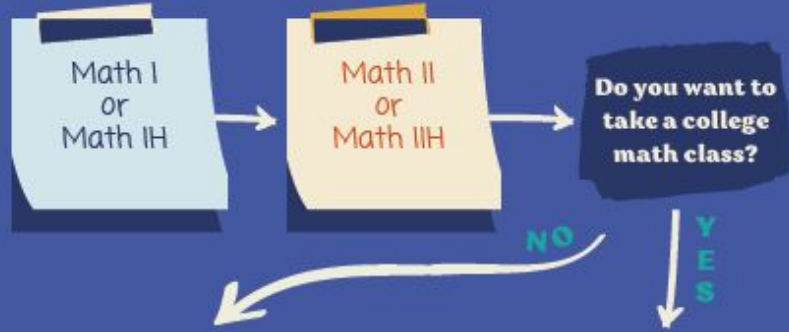

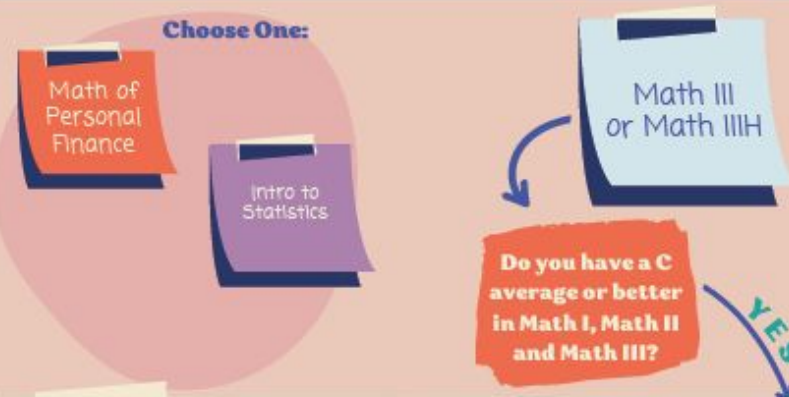

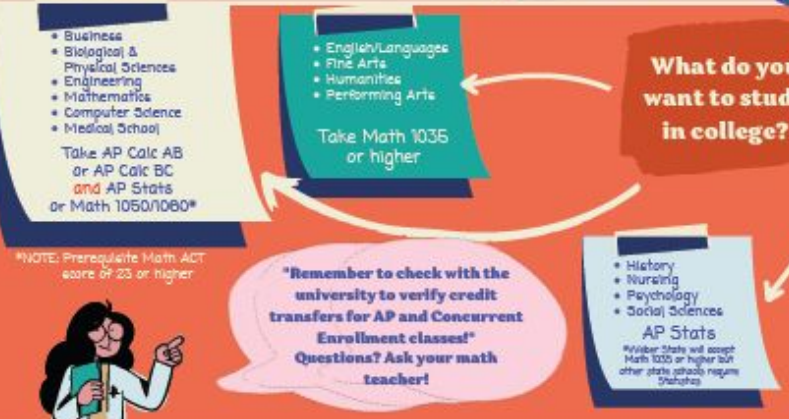
# WHICH MATH SHOULD I TAKE?
