



Diploma Program

The IB Diploma Program (IBDP) is a comprehensive and challenging pre-university program for academically motivated students in grades 11 and 12. The program is widely recognized for its high academic standards.

The IB curriculum is rigorous and challenging. IBDP graduates are better prepared for college courses and successfully complete college at a higher rate than their peers.

IB Diplomas are to be granted in addition to a Weber High School diploma, if earned by passing all coursework and exams in the 6 subject groups. In addition to the 6 subject groups, the IB program requires an additional Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course, a 3000-4000 word research based Extended Essay (EE) and the Creativity, Action, and Service (CAS) component.

Diploma Program Curriculum

Students in the IBDP must study 6 courses. Students must select one course from each group and select 3-4 HL courses and 2-3 SL courses.

- G1—IB Language and Literature HL
- G2—Spanish B SL, Ab Initio Spanish SL, or German SL
- G3—History HL
- G4—IB Biology SL, IB Biology HL, or IB Chemistry HL
- G5—IB Math SL
- G6—IB Theatre SL, IB Visual Arts SL/HL
- TOK—Theory of Knowledge

Future course offerings include Spanish HL, German HL, Chinese SL/HL, Psychology SL, Business Management SL, Exercise and Sports Science SL, Math HL, Art History HL, and Music SL/HL
