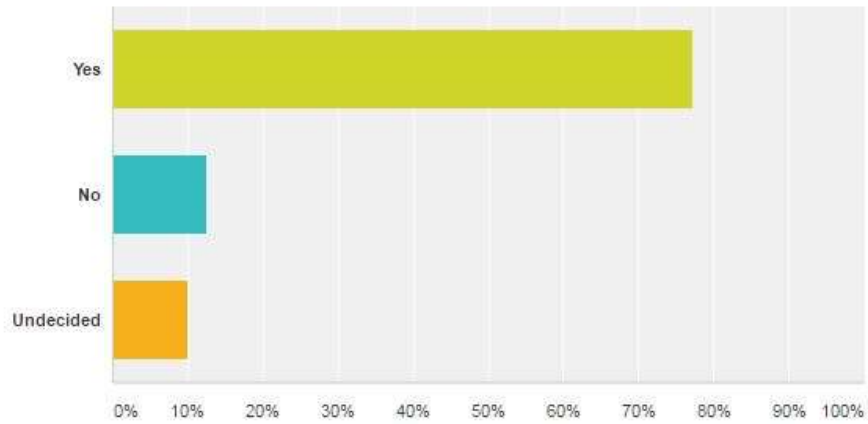

## Should Weber High continue to offer the FLEX period?

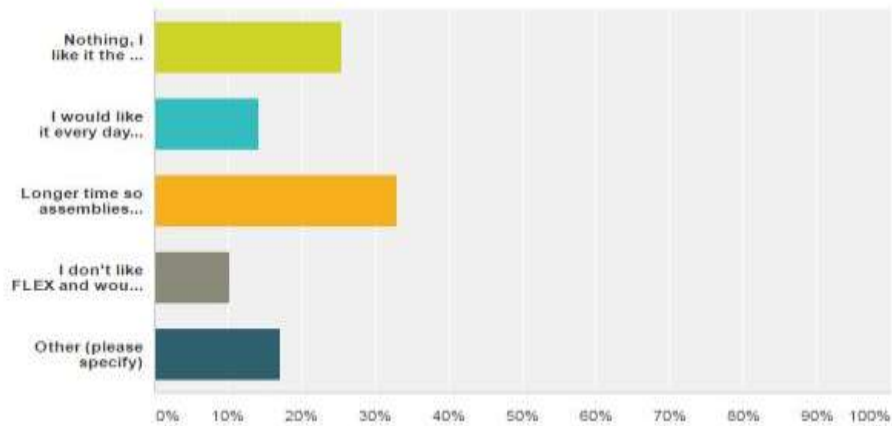
