

Tuesday, May 15th – **seniors** – Cap & Gown Pick-Up – During lunch in the triangle area next to gym balcony – east of big gym. If seniors do not pick up their cap and gown on the 15th, they will need to come to the counseling office to get it. **If a senior is not online (with academic or attendance credit) to graduate or they owe fees/fines, or they have not passed the civics test, their cap and gown will be held until they are academically cleared for graduation and/or paid all fees/fines.** Seniors need to check the graduation list posted on the window outside the counseling office to see if they are cleared for graduation.
