

To Earn an IB Diploma

- Test in all six subject areas during the junior and senior year
- 11th Grade: only SL exams (a maximum of 2) can be taken
- 12th Grade: all HL exams and any remaining SL exams not taken during 11th grade
- 24 points earned in all six subject areas are required (each exam is 1-7 points)
- Successful completion of the Extended Essay, Theory of Knowledge, and CAS
- Up to 3 bonus points can be awarded for EE and TOK
- Do not meet any Failing Conditions.

IB Failing Conditions

- CAS requirements have not been met
- Total points are fewer than 24
- An N has been given for Theory of Knowledge, Extended Essay or for any subject
- A grade of E has been awarded for Theory of Knowledge or the Extended Essay
- There is a 1 awarded in any subject
- Grade 2 has been awarded three or more times (SL or HL)
- Grade 3 or below has been awarded four or more times (SL or HL)
- Candidate has gained fewer than 12 points on HL subjects (for students taking four HL subjects the highest three grades count)
- Candidate has gained fewer than 9 points on SL subjects (students taking two SL subjects must gain at least 5 points)
