Minutes were reviewed by Chris and an error was caught in the sentence about student prevention for Edgenuity. This will be corrected. Marlisa motioned to approve the minutes and Jaclyn seconded the motion. The entire council voted to approve the minutes.

Chris presented the School Improvement Plan with revisions from the previous meeting. An updated cost of a teacher buyout, \$12,500, was changed in the plan and in the action plan, that changed the total amount for step #2 to \$87,500. The total expenditure cost for Goal #1 is \$272,500.

In Goal #2, action plan step #3,the amount that had been suggested for the LIA program transportation was reduced to \$1,000 based on the travel costs this 2022-2023 school year. The total cost for step #3 is \$2,200 (\$1,200 will be spent to cover the LIA yearly membership fee.)

Also in Goal #2, action plan step #4, the amount for teachers to attend conferences was reduced to \$5,000 from \$6,000. This was reduced due to the increase in the cost of teacher buyouts and the need to stay within spending limits.

The total expenditure cost for Goal #2 is \$15,200.

The council had a discussion on Goal #2, the purpose of the LIA program and how it is benefitting the entire school. The program was explained, examples of assemblies and activities were highlighted and how this program has allowed our ELL students to connect as well as become part of Weber High. Marlisa asked where the ELL students are coming from and Sherri Porter was able to name 4 countries we have students from.

The council asked questions about the roles of the student advocates, how they are helping students, successes we have had and challenges we still face. The addition of a 5th advocate will help with students who are not in class and hiding out in the building. Everyone agreed that when students are in class, learning takes place.

Chris asked for any more questions, none were asked and Jaclyn motioned to vote on approving the proposed plan. Angle seconded the motion, Jaclyn asked for a vote of all in favor, the council unanimously approved the plan.

No other concerns were brought up, Chris thanked the council for their input and support this year. Chris asked the council to watch for an email from the state that all

members need to complete. It is asking for their participation in the Weber High Council this year.

Sherri motioned to close the meeting which was seconded by Marlisa. The meeting was adjourned.
